DISASTER ASSISTANCE:

Transforming lives in times of crisis

Over the past decade, Rural Aid has stood alongside Australian farmers and rural communities, providing practical support during natural disasters like droughts, floods, and fires. Our work is driven by a simple goal: to support farmers before, during, and after disasters, helping them prepare, recover, adapt, and build long-term resilience.

One of our most recognised initiatives, Buy a Bale, was launched in 2015 during the drought and quickly grew into a national movement. Australians rallied together to provide essential hay and domestic water to struggling farmers. While Buy a Bale remains a core part of what we do, Rural Aid's support has expanded well beyond hay, now offering direct financial assistance, mental health services, and hands-on help through volunteer programs. Through our disaster response efforts, we've helped thousands of farmers keep their livestock fed, their household taps running, and provided financial relief to ensure farms can persevere in times of adversity.

Support isn't just about immediate relief—it's also about the long road to recovery. Our Farm Recovery Events bring volunteers together to clear debris, rebuild fences, and restore properties, while also offering emotional support and connection to ensure farmers don't face these challenges alone.

At the heart of our approach is understanding what disaster-affected farmers truly need. This means listening to communities, providing holistic support, and ensuring farmers have the financial, practical, and emotional resources to get back on their feet. By improving wellbeing, strengthening social connections, and helping farmers develop strategies to cope and recover, Rural Aid plays a crucial role in keeping rural Australia strong.





MENTAL HEALTH & WELLBEING:

Supporting farmers to thrive

Rural Aid is deeply committed to improving the mental health and wellbeing of farmers and their families, understanding that mental health is as vital as physical resources in ensuring long-term recovery. Our dedicated team of professional counsellors live and work directly within rural communities, providing tailored support to address the unique challenges of farming life.

Our counsellors offer confidential conversations and support to farmers, their families and farm workers. We offer flexible options, including phone or on-farm consultations, ensuring that help is easily accessible regardless of location. This approach is especially important for farmers who may face barriers to accessing support. We unequivocally believe that one conversation at the right time with the right person can change everything.

The demand for our mental health services has grown exponentially, as more and more farmers reach out for help in navigating the pressures they face. Thousands of counselling sessions have been provided, and our Mustering Growth school program has equipped hundreds of students with the skills to build resilience and manage adversity. Our mental health initiatives are transforming lives by fostering a culture of support, reducing stigma, and encouraging farmers to prioritise their mental health.

Looking to the future, we are more committed than ever to expanding our mental health programs and strengthening the emotional resilience of rural communities.
